

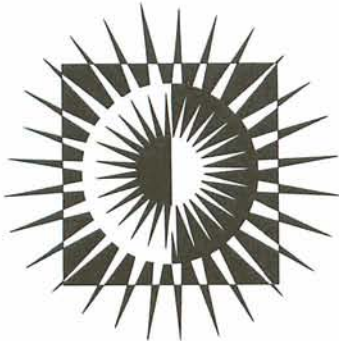

Manuscripts will not be returned; authors will be notified concerning acceptance within sixty days.

SUNSTONE is interested in feature- and column-length articles relevant to Mormonism from a variety of perspectives, news stories about Mormons and the LDS church, and poetry, psalms, and limericks. Short stories are selected only through the annual Brookie and D. K. Brown Memorial Fiction Contest (submission deadline: 1 June 1994). All fiction submissions will be considered as contest entries.

Letters for publication should be addressed to "Readers' Forum." SUNSTONE does not acknowledge receipt of letters to the editor. Letters addressed to specific authors will be forwarded unopened to them.
